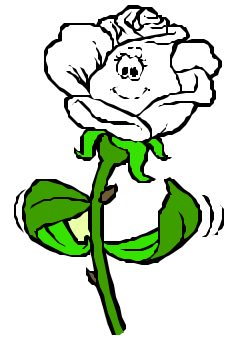
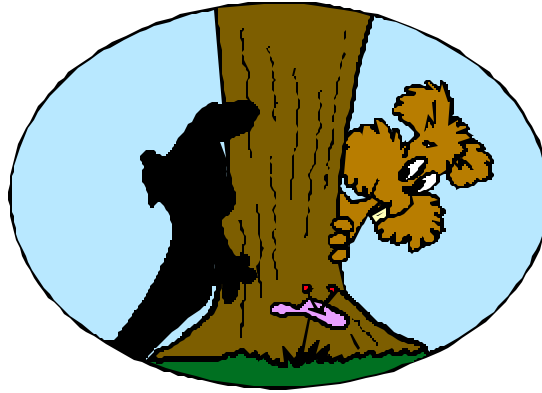


Groundhog Day Puppet

Pop-Up Ground Hog Puppet

What you need:

Scissors

Child size brown sock

Styrofoam ball

Toilet paper tissue roll

Two wiggle eyes

String or yarn

Brown felt scraps

Fiberfill

What to do:

1. Slide the sock over the tissue roll, so that the cuff opening of the sock just fits around the edge of the tissue roll. The tissue roll will be the groundhog's hole.
2. Dip one end of stick in glue, then push it into the Styrofoam ball (let dry). Push the ball through the tissue roll and into the toe of the sock, with the stick coming out of the bottom of the tissue roll. The ball will be the head of the groundhog. Tie a piece of string around the stick at the base of the Styrofoam ball to make the groundhog's neck.
3. Glue the two wiggle eyes on one side of the head. Cut the ears and a nose from the brown felt and glue them into place.
4. Glue fiberfill around the top rim of the tissue roll for snow. Push on the stick to pop your groundhog up out of the hole to see if he sees his shadow. If he does, pull on the stick to put him back in his hole for six more weeks of winter!

Six more weeks of winter! OH NO!!!
